

Scholarship America Dream Award

Scholarship America Dream Award is a renewable scholarship ranging between \$5,000 and \$15,000, depending on the need. Award amounts will grow by \$1,000 each year, helping to ensure that students can afford to complete their degrees.

Applicants must:

- Be at least 17 years of age.
- Be U.S. citizens, U.S. permanent residents (holders of a Permanent Resident card), or individuals granted deferred action status under the Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals program (DACA).
- Have received a high school diploma or the equivalent from a U.S. school by September 2020.
- Have completed or expect to successfully complete a minimum of one full year of postsecondary education by June 2021.
- Plan to enroll in full-time undergraduate study at the sophomore year level or higher at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school in the United States for the entire 2021–22 academic year.
- Be studying to obtain an associate's or first bachelor's degree.
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or its equivalent).
- Demonstrate financial need.
